- Winners of a category from 2011 are ineligible to enter that particular category for the 2012 competition.
- The closing date for entries is Friday 22 June 2012.
- Judging will take place, on or around, the first or second week in July (Weather dependant).
- A entrants give their permission for photographs to be used for publicity purposes on behalf of the Town Council.
- All trophies may remain in the possession of the winners , but must be returned to the Town Council (who retain ownership) by 1 June 2013.

- Winner of the Best Kept Garden. The "Parish Trophy", certificate and a cheque for £200.
- Runner-Up for the Best Kept Garden , a certificate and a cheque for £150.
- Third Prize for the Best Kept Garden, a certificate and a cheque for £100.
- Fourth Prize for the Best Kept Garden, a certificate and a cheque for £50.
- Most Colourful Garden winner receives the "Ford Trophy" a certificate and a cheque for £50.
- The Best Hanging Basket Display receives a certificate and a cheque for £50.
